- **Clear guidance**, especially for our sons as they are in times of transition.
- **Peace and godliness** to prevail here in the Aiyura Valley and in our hearts.
- **Protection** from spiritual and physical hazards for our whole family.
- **Effectiveness** in ministry.
- God to **bless our partners**.
