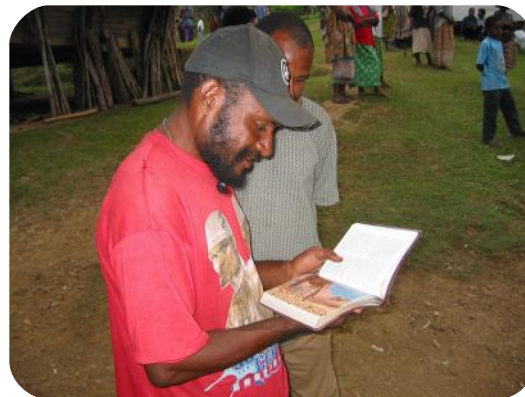

Numanggang: Transformed by the Word of God

We recently passed a significant milestone: one full decade of full-time Christian missionary service. In retrospect, we have a great deal to give glory to God about. I'll focus on just one people group of many that we have touched: Numanggang.

The home of the Numanggang people is in a beautiful mountain region of the Morobe Province of Papua New Guinea. There are about 3,000 speakers of the Numanggang language, mostly in their 10 home villages. Some of them have moved to larger cities with Internet access.

Before the Word of God came to Numanggang, these people were fierce warriors, likely to kill and eat enemies. Now, they are peaceful, with a well-established church. Their New Testament and Psalms were dedicated in print form in January 2006. It was typeset using software that I wrote.

I also got to help the Numanggang people by putting their Scriptures on the Internet. As work progresses on Bible translation and audio recording, I'll be happy to post more.

Without the support of financial and prayer partners, this would not have been possible. Thank you.
